This instruction sheet is provided to help clarify the information needed on the Internet Data Exchange (IDX) Agreement. Members will be contacted periodically to confirm that the information in their IDX agreements is correct and up to date. Members are responsible for ensuring that the use of the data obtained through their IDX access complies with CRIS Rules and Regulations.
